ABA Clinically Proven Principles

FUNCTIONAL COMMUNICATION TRAINING

APPLIED BEHAVIORAL ANALYSIS (ABA) FOCUSES ON LEARNING TO LEARN BY USING CLINICALLY PROVEN PRINCIPLES AND TEACHING STRATEGIES. THESE TEACHING STRATEGIES FOCUS ON INCREASING SKILLS, SUCH AS PROSOCIAL BEHAVIORS, COPING TOOLS, DAILY LIVING SKILLS, AND COMMUNICATION.

All behavior is communication. Our goal is to teach the child new communication is more "functional" (and even more reinforcing) than what they are currently utilizing. However, before we can begin to teach an alternative behavior, it is critical to first know why the child is engaging in the challenging behavior. We ask, "what are they trying to communicate?" when the behavior occurs. This can be determined by cuing into antecedents and consequences that are occurring with the behavior. If the child is screaming and pulling on mom when she is on the phone, for example, and then mom stops and gives the child attention, it could be determined that the purpose was to obtain attention. We can then target how the child could use a more functional way to gain that attention.

Here are a few things to keep in mind when replacing challenging behaviors with more functional behavior:

- 1. The replacement should work quickly for the child. This will help them learn that the "functional" way can be more effective than their previous way of communicating.
- 2. The replacement should work every time, across all situations, people, and settings.
- 3. The replacement should require less effort than the challenging behavior while still getting their same needs met.
